

MNEMOART , Paris 2008

MNEMOART proposes to think about art and psychoanalysis, with the help of science, as a poetic writing against forgetting.

Mnemoart is an experimental research group founded by Tamara and Jean-Pierre Landau, both of whom are psychoanalysts and artists actively involved in an original elaboration around psychoanalysis, creation, time and the different forms of writing.

We are seeking to create a new language linking psychoanalysis to art and science through artistic exchanges, encounters and events of high quality.

The current projects of MNEMOART are:

1. The 5th Franco-Italian meeting around Tamara Landau's seminar on the concept of the enclave linking psychoanalysis to art and science with different poetic writings.
2. Two or three times a year, events (video, exhibitions, ephemerals, performances) translate one of the current elaborations of the research group .
3. A large-scale international conference in 2011 around the theme "Psychoanalysis with the arts and science".
4. Promotion of books and films on the memory of the Shoah, and the translation and publication of Matei Gal's book *The Beauty of Hope* on the International Jewish Brigades, to be published in 2008 by Duna, Budapest.
- 5. Creation in 2012 of the "Villa-Landau" in Nice as a place of exchange, creation, exhibitions, and residence for artists, psychoanalysts and scientists in memory of the artists and scientists of the Landau family : Bella and Zygmunt Landau, painter of the École de Paris, Lev D. Landau, Nobel prize for physics, and Adolphe Landau, film producer.
